What We Did

We worked with the Interior Designers on the 'look and feel' of bedrooms, shared communal areas and amenities to bring the property fully up to date. The theme was based on the famous Glaswegian architect Charles Rennie Mackintosh, utilising local fabrics and designs to ensure the building reflected the local community.

We also recommended adding a gym to ensure facilities were in-line with those of our closest competitors in the city.

To minimise impact on residents and reduce any impact on income, we were able to keep the building open throughout the refurb programme, working closely with our Client to ensure that works were completed one block at a time.

The Result

Upon completion we were able to achieve a 34% rent increase for our Client and maintain 100% occupancy.
